A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER SOUTHAMPTON, COUNTY OF BUCKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A "NO LEFT TURN" SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF STUMP ROAD AND STREET ROAD FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 90 DAYS.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Stump Road and Street Road has been designated by Pennsylvania Department of Transportation as the location for a traffic light; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wish to regulate said intersection to permit right turns only from Stump Road onto Street Road until such time as said traffic light is installed; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 15, Subsection 105 of the Upper Southampton Township Code of Ordinances empowers the Board of Supervisors to designate places upon and along the highways in the Township where for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, specific traffic and/or parking regulation, prohibitions, and restrictions shall be in force and effect, and shall designate such locations by proper signs and markings in order to allow for the test and experimental determination of the feasibility and desirability of permanent changes in the Ordinances of the Township relative to traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to exercise the powers provided for in Chapter 15, Subsection 105 by placing a "No Left Turn" sign on Stump Road where it intersects with Street Road for the purpose of determining whether it is desirable and feasible to permanently regulate this intersection until such time as a traffic signal is installed

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Upper Southampton Township, Resolves:


1. That it shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle, traveling upon the first-named street at any of the following intersections, in the direction or directions indicated in each case, to make other than a right turn, at any time stated, both left turns and straight-across traffic being prohibited:

| Stump | Southerly | All | Street Road |

2. That a "No Left Turn" sign be installed at the intersection of Stump Road and Street Road, as provided in Paragraph 1 above for a period not to exceed 90 days for the determination of the feasibility and desirability of any permanent changes and are listed below in accordance with Chapter 15, Subsection 207 as established in the Upper Southampton Township Code of Ordinances.
3. Any person who shall violate the said regulation shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25 00) together with the cost of prosecution
4. The provisions of Chapter 15, Subsection 105 are hereby fully incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Resolution without attachment hereto.
5. This Resolution shall become immediately effective upon its enactment.
