**WHEREAS**, the Township Board of Supervisors of Upper Southampton recognizes the benefit of forming a partnership with other municipalities and interested parties along the Neshaminy creek in protection of the Delaware River; and,

**WHEREAS**, Act 1993-50 authorized the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to provide grant funds to local governments, municipal authorities, and appropriate non-profit organizations for rivers planning, implementation and technical assistance programs;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Board of Supervisors of Upper Southampton, supports the application of the Heritage Conservancy to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to create a River Conservation Plan for that section of the Neshaminy Creek from the northern boundary of the Mill Creek in Township of Northampton to the southern boundary of Hulmeville Borough in the County of Bucks
