

**RESOLUTION #2002-15**

**BUCKS COUNTY MUNICIPAL LAND ACQUISITION GRANT  
TOWNSHIP OF UPPER SOUTHAMPTON  
BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Southampton recognizes that the Township contains open space and natural areas that contribute to the quality of life and economic health of our community which are worthy of preservation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners of Bucks County have established the Bucks County Municipal Open Space Program through a referendum overwhelmingly passed by Bucks County Voters on May 20, 1997; and

**WHEREAS**, the program provides for Municipal Land Acquisition Grants that may be used by the municipality to acquire land to protect natural areas, preserve agriculture, or provide park and recreation facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Upper Southampton, Bucks County, Pennsylvania wishes to participate in the Municipal Open Space Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the municipality will have available its required match,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of the Township of Upper Southampton, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:



That the Township of Upper Southampton, Bucks County, Pennsylvania hereby approves the filing of an application for a Municipal Land Acquisition Grant under the Municipal Open Space Program to acquire property located at 1176 Second Street Pike, Southampton, PA, TMP# 48-014-009 and TMP# 48-014-010-002.
2. That **Joseph W. Golden**, is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the appropriate forms with the Bucks County Open Space Review Board.
