

RESOLUTION # 2003-18

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF UPPER SOUTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF BUCKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TOWNSHIP SOLICITOR TO FILE A PETITION WITH THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REQUESTING COURT APPROVAL FOR THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO LEVY AND ASSESS A TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF 19 MILLS FOR GENERAL TOWNSHIP PURPOSES UPON REAL ESTATE LOCATED WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP FOR THE YEAR 2004.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Upper Southampton, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, at its regular meeting held on November 5, 2003, proposed a budget for the year of 2004 requiring the levy and assessment of millage in excess of 14 mills upon real estate located within Upper Southampton Township for general township purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code requires the Board of Supervisors to petition and acquire approval of the Court of Common Pleas of Bucks County, Pennsylvania, in order to levy and assess a tax in excess of 14 mills for general township purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors deems it to be financially necessary and in the best interests of Upper Southampton Township and the residents thereof to levy and assess a tax upon said real estate in the amount of 19 mills for general township purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Southampton Township and it is hereby resolved by the authority thereof as follows:


1. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the Township Solicitor to file a Petition with the Court of Common Pleas of Bucks County, Pennsylvania, requesting Court approval for Board of Supervisors to levy and assess, for the 2004 tax year, a tax upon real estate located within Upper Southampton Township for general Township purposes in the amount of 19 mills.

2. The Officers of Board of Supervisors and the Township Manager are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file a Petition for said purpose as prepared by the Township Solicitor.


