

**RESOLUTION #2004-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER SOUTHAMPTON, COUNTY OF BUCKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA REDUCING THE REAL ESTATE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2005 AS A RESULT OF A COUNTY-WIDE REVISION OF ASSESSMENT OF REAL PROPERTY.**

**BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED** by the Board of Supervisors of Upper Southampton Township, County of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

Section 1. For the sole purpose of complying with the Act 91 of 2004 (72 P.S. Section 5020-404) and as a result of the change in the established pre-determined ratio from 25% to 100% of the 1972 assessed value of real property effective January 1, 2005, the tax rate on all real property located in Upper Southampton Township for the fiscal year 2005 is hereby reduced so that the total amount of taxes preliminarily levied for 2005 is equal to the total amount of taxes levied for 2004, with said tax rates as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of on each hundred dollars of assessed valuation:	4.75 mills 47.50 cents
For debt purposes, the sum of on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation	2.1875 mills 21.875 cents
For street lighting purposes, the sum of on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation	0.9625 mills 9.625 cents
For fire hydrant purposes, the sum of on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation	0.125 mills 1.25 cents
For fire protection purposes, the sum of on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation	1.05 mills 10.5 cents
For park & recreation purposes, the sum of on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation	1.9325 mills 19.325 cents
For library purposes, the sum of on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation	1.75 mills 17.50 cents

For rescue squad purposes, the sum of 475 mills  
on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of 4.75 cents  
on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

For open space purposes, the sum of 0.75 mills  
on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of 7.50 cents  
on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

The same being summarized in tabular form as follows:



Tax rate for general purposes	4.75	47.50
Tax rate for debt purposes	2.1875	21.875
Tax rate for streetlights	0.9625	9.625
Tax rate for fire hydrants	0.125	1.25
Tax rate for fire protection	1.05	10.5
Tax rate for parks & recreation	1.9325	19.325
Tax rate for library	1.75	17.50
Tax rate for rescue squad	.475	4.75
Tax rate for open space	0.75	7.50


Section 2. Resolution 2003-20 which established the tax rate for 2004 and remains in effect for 2004 is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The establishment of the final tax rate, if said tax rate is higher than the preliminary tax rate, shall be by separate Resolution and any tax increase shall not be greater than ten per centum than the total amount levied in 2004.

Section 4. That any part of a resolution conflicting with this resolution is repealed
