

TOWNSHIP OF UPPER SOUTHAMPTON

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-17

WHEREAS, Act No. 511 of the 1965 General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, enacted December 31, 1965, and effective January 1, 1966, authorizes certain political subdivisions, including Upper Southampton Township, Bucks County, to levy, assess and collect a tax on individuals for the privilege of engaging in an occupation, as therein with more particularity specified, generally and hereinafter referred to as the Local Services Tax; and

WHEREAS, Upper Southampton Township, Bucks County, by Resolution and/or Ordinance, has levied, assessed and provided for the collection of such Local Services Tax; and

WHEREAS, Section 10 of said Act of 1965, specifies that any such political subdivision may provide for the creation of such bureaus or the appointment and compensation of such officers, clerks, collectors and other assistants and employees as may be deemed necessary for the assessment and collection of taxes imposed under the authority of that Act; and

WHEREAS, the Upper Southampton Township Board of Supervisors and the Keystone Collection Group entered into an Agreement for the collection of Local Services Tax levied by Upper Southampton Township, Bucks County; and


WHEREAS, Upper Southampton Township, Bucks County, recognizes the legal obligation and practical necessity for Keystone Collection Group to establish and maintain consistent rules and regulations to be used in the efficient administration and collection of said taxes;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Upper Southampton Township, Bucks County, hereby appoints Keystone Collection Group as its collector of Local Services Taxes and further, adopts and incorporates the Local Services Tax Rules and Regulations as promulgated by the

Keystone Collection Group in their entirety.
