RESOLUTION NO. 2011-17

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE BUCKS COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM AND DESIGNATING CONTACT PERSON.

WHEREAS, Upper Southampton Township is a legal entity as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (hereinafter referred to as "the Applicant"); and,

WHEREAS, the Applicant intends to submit an application to the Bucks County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, requesting funding assistance under Program Year 2012 to construction handicapped ramps throughout the Township; and,

WHEREAS, Upper Southampton Township desires to give meaning to the guarantees of equal rights contained in the Constitution and laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the United States, and to encourage and bring about mutual self-respect and understanding among all citizens and groups; and,

WHEREAS, under the Federal Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, it is illegal to deny housing to any person because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin; and,

WHEREAS, under the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act of 1955, (P.L. 744, No. 222) as amended and supplemented, it is illegal to deny housing or employment to any person because of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, age, sex, national origin, handicap or disability or the use of a support animal because of the blindness, deafness or physical disability;

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the submission of the application for funding assistance to the Bucks County Community Development Block Grant Program for the aforementioned project is hereby authorized; and;


FURTHER, authorize Joseph W. Golden to be the official contact person of the Applicant, as listed in Page 1 of the application, throughout the application review and approval process; and,

FURTHER, Upper Southampton Township agrees to notify the Bucks County Department of Community and Business Development in writing if any of the information contained in this application changes and, to execute a written agreement with the County of Bucks before commencing any work or expending any funds on this project; and

FURTHER, Upper Southampton Township makes a firm commitment to do all within its power to eliminate prejudice, intolerance, disorder and discrimination and assist the County affirmatively furthering fair housing.
