

# Refund Policy

**If We Cancel A Program:** Upper Southampton Township Parks & Recreation reserves the right to cancel classes/ activities due to insufficient enrollment or other unforeseen circumstances.

Participants will be notified and full refunds given. Credit card refunds will be issued within three days of the class/activity being canceled. If payment was made by cash or check, refunds may take up to 30 days from the date the course/activity was canceled.

**If Participant Withdraws/Cancel:** To cancel a registration participants must contact Upper Southampton Township Parks & Recreation at 215-355-9781. PLEASE NOTE: Instructors are not authorized to issue refunds or credits.

**Refund:** If the Parks and Recreation Department is notified of a withdrawal at least seven full days prior to the start of the class/activity, a refund will be issued. Refunds are issued by check or credit to a credit card. A processing fee of \$5.00 per program will be assessed for all canceled programs. We do not give refunds for camps.

**Credit:** If the withdrawal is between 48 hours and seven days prior to the start of the program, a Parks & Recreation credit will be placed on your household account, to be applied for future programs. A processing fee of \$5.00 per program will be assessed for all canceled registrations.

**Cancellation and Changes of Programs:** All classes must have a minimum number of participants enrolled in order to be held. Upper Southampton Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel or make any necessary revisions.

**NO CREDITS or REFUNDS** for any program will be issued if the withdrawal request is made less than 48 hours prior to the start of the program. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

## FARMERS MARKET AT TAMANEND PARK

Season opens June 1, 2017, every Thursday, RAIN OR SHINE, through September, 3:30-6:30 PM.

We will be offering an environment for farmers and residents of Bucks County to enjoy a healthful and fresh market of locally grown products. For this reason every market vendor is obligated to personally produce all of the items that they sell so that every-one purchasing foods, flowers or crafts can trust that they are receiving the best products.

The market takes place outdoors in the open air of Tamanend Park, which allows vendors to sell from the back of their trucks using tables and canopies. The vendor will have complete knowledge of their own production practices, harvest dates, etc., so feel free to ask them any questions you may have.

The market supervisor does reserve the right to allow some items that are not personally produced but do fit our criteria of quality, wholesome, fresh and nutritional foods.

## TAMANEND PARK HERB GARDEN CLUB

The Tamanend Park Herb Garden Club was started in the summer of 1983 by four residents of Upper Southampton Township who were interested in the various aspects of herb gardening and herb use. The Herb Club now has over 60 members! On the third weekend of May every year the Herb Club holds their annual herb sale. This is held in conjunction with the Friends of Tamanend Flea Market and the Art Club art sale. Profits raised by the Herb sale go towards high school and college scholarships. The Club gives a \$1,000 college scholarship and a \$500 high school scholarship to students planning a career in horticulture. The Herb Garden Club meets on the third Wednesday of each month from January through November. Meetings start at 7:30 PM at the Tamanend Park Farmhouse with a brief business meeting, followed by a guest speaker or a group activity. Dues are \$5 a year.



# Mad Science



## MARVELS OF MOTION

Come one, come all to the Mad Science Physics Olympics! This interactive event is all about the fun-damentals of moving science, including Newton's 3 Laws of Motion and all sorts of surprises including dancing, chemically assisted football tossing, and even amazing "space-age" rocket packs. 


